Lift Tickets

Standard package prices include a 5 or 6-day adult lift pass. Ski all four mountains of one of the most iconic interconnect areas in North America! BRSC is based in Snowmass, but your ski pass allows unrestricted access to not just the former, but to Buttermilk, Ajax (Aspen) Mountain and Aspen Highlands as well! Pricing is available for additional or fewer ski days, along with rates for Seniors.

United and other Flight Options

As of July, United is the exclusive airline supplier for the 2020 Western Winter Carnival. All participating clubs are currently scheduled to fly into DENVER; airfare is significantly less expensive and travel into Denver is far more accessible in the Winter season than flying into Aspen, or even Eagle Vail.

SOUTHWEST AIRLINES introduces its nonstop service for the ski season in August. We expect that most groups will switch their reservations to the former to save money on baggage fees. ***Further information with regards to available options on Southwest will become available on Monday, August 19th.***

Council Transportation

Arrow Stage Lines will swiftly take the Council up into the Rocky Mountains, a scenic five-hour drive with a stop for groceries along the way.

BRSC Race

Tuesday January 28th will bring BRSC's final NASTAR race competition. Participants will have two runs, one through each set of gates, where skiers will be timed for recognition and awards at the farewell party. The course is located just above the Spider Sabich picnic area at the resort; check your trailmap for further information.

A "neck wallet" credential for each participant is included in each package, detailing name and member club for each participant. Your wallet can also be used to store drink tickets and other items you may want to keep handy during social functions.

Non-skiing activities

Although Snowmass, Colorado is best known for its unparalleled variety of skiing & snowboarding terrain, there are plenty of non-ski activities to do here besides hitting the slopes.

- 1. Snow Tubing:** Perfect for all members of the family, the tubing center is located at Elk Camp, offering seven one-hour sessions daily. The sessions begin at 10am, 10:30am, 11am, 1pm, 1:30pm, 2pm and 2:30pm. Five additional sessions are available Fridays during Ullr Nights at 5:30pm, 6pm, 6:30pm, 7pm and 7:30pm
- 2. Bowling:** Conveniently located in Snowmass Mall, Snowmass Lanes & Lounge is an ideal rendezvous point for skiers and non-skiers. With 8 lanes, a full service kitchen, several HDTV's and 2 huge projector screens, this is a fun place to unwind with friends and family.
- 3. Snowmobile to the Maroon Bells:** With the road closed in the winter, experience the Maroon Bells in a more adventurous and intimate way. Take a guided snowmobile tour through the Snowmass Wilderness all the way to Maroon Lake, complete with a cup of hot cocoa upon arrival. With single and double rider options, and no experience necessary, this is sure to be a vacation highlight.
- 4. Dog Sledding** at Krabloonik: Hop in the sled, and take in the mountain scenery through aspen groves and wide-open meadows. 10 dogs and experienced mushers whisk you to a gourmet meal in a remote, quaint cabin. A winter adventure defined.
- 5. Cross-Country Skiing:** Starting from the Snowmass Cross-Country Ski and Snowshoe Center, stride and glide through over 60 miles of Nordic trail in the Aspen/Snowmass area. The trails offer exceptional views, looking up-valley towards Mt. Daly.
